The Otway Fly Treetop Walk is a major tourist attraction in the Otway Ranges off the Great Ocean Road. Situated in a combination of wet sclerophyll and cool temperate rainforest, the Otway Fly Treetop Walk provides students with a great opportunity to see the diversity of an Australian forest.

The Otway Fly Treetop Walk is the longest and tallest steel structured canopy walkway in the world. The students get a real thrill, climbing the 47m spiral tower into the tree canopy and walking out on the rocking cantilever. We offer a diverse range of educational programs tailored to suit your needs and we are dedicated to environmentally sustainable experience. As part of our commitment, we have developed a quality range of education programs to help students learn more about the history, diversity and the changing attitudes towards forests of the Otway Ranges.

Forest ecology, logging history, plant and animal identification, looking after the environment, bush foods and sustainable tourism are incorporated into each program. All programs have the option of pre or post visit materials including worksheets, fact-sheets and activities.

In addition to our guided or self guided tours, we can add to your groups experience by offering options of abseiling off the fly down to the forest floor as well as our new Zip Line Tour Product.

The first of its kind in Victoria, the Zip Line Tour involves traversing from one platform to another connected by tree platforms called 'cloud stations', whirled attached to a steel cable suspended up to 30m above the forest floor. When you come back to ground, you' can continue on to enjoy the Otway Fly Treetop Walk.

The Zip Line Tour is guided by trained and experienced guides. Our guides will provide you with an insight into our forest's history and its features and provide you with an experience you won't forget! The Zip Line Tour is classified as a "medium" adrenalin activity.

A visit to the Otway Fly Treetop Walk can be incorporated into a school camp or as a day visit. If you would like any more information about our education programs, please don't hesitate to call us.

- Minimum size of group is 10 students for the Tree Top Walk & 12 students for Zip Line Tour;
- Bookings must be made at least 7 days in advance including optional extras (i.e. catering);
- Numbers, arrival time and catering requirements (if applicable) to be finalised 24 hours prior to arrival;
- School packages are only available to legitimate school groups;
- School groups are entitled to 1 complimentary teacher when accompanying 10 paying students for the Tree Top Walk and 12 paying students for the Zip Line Tour;
- No verbal bookings allowed; bookings will be confirmed upon completion of our "Education Booking Application Form";
- Payment must be paid in one transaction per group;
- Invoicing after your visit only available if the required credit application documentation has been complete prior to arrival. Otherwise payment is required prior to entry to the walk;
- If a booking containing either guided tours (including Zip Line Tours) and or catering is cancelled outside of the required 24 hours notice, the organiser may be held liable for full payment of catering (as quoted);
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your tours departures for guided Tree Top Walks and Zip Line Tours;
